HP Actions Taken To Date

- Provided new and/or remarketed add-ons for A-/N-Class servers through 10/31/2004 (CPUs, embedded disks, memory, I/O and network cards)
- Providing new and/or remarketed external storage for A-/N-Class servers after 2003, limited by supply/demand
- Set up an internal process for handling e3000 hardware inquiries from customers
- Continuing to install remarketed or used 3000 boards at T&M through end-of-support
- Extended the availability of select MPE/iX add-on software products beyond the initial end-of-sales date through 9/30/2006
- Continuing a software license transfer process beyond endof-sales and end-of-support

HP Actions Taken To Date

- Extended support of MPE/iX 6.5 through 2006
- Extended support of all 9x8, 9x9KS, 99x platforms through 2006
- Extended 3000->9000 conversion kits through 2006
- Extended 9x8, 9x9, 99x user license upgrades through 2006
- Continuing to provide e3000 manuals and documentation on either docs.hp.com or via thirdparty partners

HP Actions Taken To Date

- Enhanced MPE/iX to mount "big" disks
- Licensed MPE/iX training materials from HP Education to a third-party partner(s)
- Posted a web site on Jazz that is updated with the list of patches that are in Beta Test (BT) status
